The Trustees met and came to the conclusion that there was insufficient support to enable us to continue with the plans for the Celebration. Having made this difficult decision we then looked at the purpose of PWL and after much prayer and discussion came to the conclusion that the company should be closed. We have a sense of great thanksgiving for all that People Without Limits has been and done and whilst grieving the loss of something that we love so much and that has been such an important part of the lives of so many, we do feel that there is a new season approaching and trust that God has a plan'.


