#### Building works update:

<u>Roofing Work</u> – By now you may have noticed scaffolding around the church. This is to enable roofing repairs to be carried out following the storm damage last March, and also significant wear and tear to the roof that has occurred over a number of years.

Accessible Toilet Project – A significant hurdle has now been overcome with the Diocesan Advisory Committee accepting our plans, subject to some minor changes. Once the final drawings have been submitted we can go out to tender for contractors to undertake the building work. We hope that this process will start within the next month. Our realistic projection at this stage is that work will commence soon after Christmas and be completed around the end of April/early May 2017.

<u>Old Vicarage site boundary wall</u> – after many years of 'leaning' this has now started to collapse. We are actively seeking the best way forward for suitable repairs or rebuilding.
