<u>Sun 23rd April:</u> 10.30am Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM) in Church as part of our worship.

We need to nominate and elect 3 Deanery Synod and 4 PCC members and choose 2 Churchwardens – please think and pray for wisdom as to who might fill these vacancies. Nomination forms will be available soon.

To vote at the APCM you need to be on our membership list, the 'Electoral Roll'. If you are already on it, there is no need to re-apply; however anyone else must fill in an application form. You need to be a) over 16 years old, b) have been baptised (as a child or adult in any Christian denomination) and c) either live in the parish **or** have attended St. Mark's for at least 6 months.

Application forms are available at the back of church or in the office. The list will close on 26th March until after the APCM.

Some of you may know that the charity Compassion has had to withdraw from India. There is another small Christian charity called TREAD who have permission to continue supporting vulnerable children in India. If you would like further information, please speak to Mike and Denise Young.
