FAMILY NEWS


<u>Sun 25th March:</u> 10.30am Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM) in Church as part of our worship.

We need to nominate and elect 4 PCC members and choose 2 Churchwardens – please think and pray for wisdom as to who might fill these vacancies. Nomination forms will be available soon.

To vote at the APCM you need to be on our membership list, the 'Electoral Roll'. If you are already on it, there is no need to re-apply; however anyone else must fill in an application form. You need to be a) over 16 years old, b) have been baptised (as a child or adult in any Christian denomination) and c) either live in the parish or have attended St. Mark's for at least 6 months.

Application forms are available at the back of church or in the office. The list will close following the service on Sunday, 4th March until after the APCM.
