POINTS FOR PRAISE AND PRAYER

"And Hezekiah prayed this prayer before the LORD: "O LORD, God of Israel, You are enthroned between the mighty cherubim! You alone are God of all the kingdoms of the earth. You alone created the heavens and the earth." 2 Kings 19:15 (New Living Translation Bible)

O LORD God thank you again that 'You alone are God of all the kingdoms [and peoples] of the earth'. Please bring Your wisdom, love and mercy in to our fallen world because we desperately need You. For Your glory's sake, Amen.
