

Please pray especially this month for the Mbembe translation teams in south-east Nigeria:

*Ernest Ebak: For restored health and full strength, after suffering from what may have been typhoid. (In addition to the spread of coronavirus, outbreaks of typhoid and cholera are currently reported in Nigeria. Doctors are still on strike.)

*John Afro: For healing from long-term health issues - a lame leg and painful back (following a motorbike accident) - and pressing family responsibilities. They rejoice in the safe birth of a baby boy to join his three year old sister. The baby's name is Kw'Atte, literally "of the Father", meaning "belonging to God".

*Four newly-appointed Mbembe team members are now training to become translators: learning to use a computer, learning the Paratext software program, absorbing the principles of Bible translation and developing their skills in applying these.

*Breakdowns in internet connections and in power supply are challenging, as we continue to work over the internet, using Zoom, to check translations.

There are still ongoing reports of attacks against Christian communities in northern Nigeria, and the middle belt. Please pray!

Thank God for many committed Christ-followers in Nigeria as they share the gospel and witness to the teaching of Jesus Christ.
